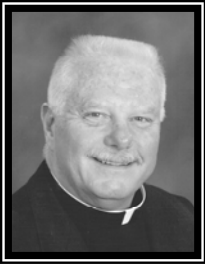
**Neglect**

Neglect is the most common form of child abuse. It is the failure to meet a child's basic needs, including housing, food, clothing, education, safety and access to health care. Neglect is most often characterized by acts of omission that aren't easy to see. The signs of neglect are wide and varied, and may include: failure to develop and grow appropriately, or malnourishment, among infants; wearing inadequate clothing for the weather; and children who seem to be wholly responsible for the welfare of their siblings. If you know that any type of abuse is occurring, or if a child discloses to you, it is important to communicate these concerns to the appropriate authorities. Call your local law enforcement or child protective services department to report suspected abuse of any kind. ## From our Pastor, Fr. John Higgins

As many of you remember I came to St. Raymond in the Summer of 2003, fifteen years ago. I spent three years as "Administrator" of the Parish and then was made Pastor. That was 12 years ago. This is the longest I have ever lived anywhere. I could count the times I've moved, but it would take too long and I'd need a calculator. This is the end of my 12-year assignment, but having reached and passed age 65 there and there is a Church Law that allows Priests to stay in their parish with the approval of the Archbishop. I have received a letter confirming that I will be assigned to St. Raymond as Pastor until I hear otherwise from the Archbishop of Los Angeles. I will stay as long as I can, which will be several more years, I am sure.

If I were leaving I would reminisce here about all of the wonderful years I have had at St. Raymond among you and all those who have been here and are no longer with us because of moving away or their final call Home. I would thank all of you who have been so kind to me, supported me in all sorts of things from difficulties with parish problems to problems with surgeries and other health issues. I'd thank all of you who have seen me make mistakes and blunders and have either gently guided me through them or laughed with me as I realized what a big goof I had made. I would be sure and thank our Parish Staff, the many volunteers who do so many wonderful things for others in this Parish and in the Greater Church. I would thank Cardinal Archbishop Mahoney for assigning me to this Parish, bringing me back to Downey where I lived and went to high school and early college and then went off to the Seminary from our neighbor Parish, Our Lady of Perpetual Help.

Now that I am staying I must ask a difficult question. What are we doing to prepare for a new Pastor for the day when I do retire? Are we encouraging young men to think about a vocation to the Priesthood? Do you mention it in conversations at home or with young people? Let's think of ways that we can encourage people to answer God's call to service as Priests and Sisters.



Como muchos de ustedes recuerdan, llegué a San Ramón en el verano del 2003, hace quince años. Pasé tres años como "Administrador" de la Parroquia y luego fui nombrado Pastor. Eso fue hace 12 años. Este ha sido el tiempo más largo que he vivido en alguna parte. Podría contar las veces que me mudé, pero tomaría demasiado tiempo y ocuparía una calculadora. Este es el final de mi asignación de 12 años, pero después de haber cumplido los 65 años de edad, existe una Ley de la Iglesia que permite a los sacerdotes permanecer en su parroquia con la aprobación del Arzobispo. He recibido una carta que confirma que sigo siendo asignado como Pastor de San Ramón hasta que escuche lo contrario del Arzobispo de Los Ángeles. Me quedará lo más tiempo que pueda, que serán varios años más, de eso estoy seguro.

Si me estuviera yendo, recordaría aquí todos los maravillosos años que he pasado en San Ramón, entre ustedes y todos aquellos que han estado aquí, ya sea por haberse mudado o por su llamada final con nuestro Señor. Les agradecería a todos ustedes que han sido tan amables conmigo, me han apoyado en todo tipo de cosas, desde dificultades con problemas parroquiales, hasta problemas con cirugías y otros problemas de salud. Les agradecería a todos ustedes que me han visto cometer errores y que o bien me han ayudado o se han reído conmigo al darme cuenta de lo mucho que me había equivocado. Les agradecería a nuestro personal parroquial, a los muchos voluntarios que hacen tantas cosas maravillosas para los demás en esta parroquia y en la Gran Iglesia. Le agradecería al Cardenal Arzobispo Mahoney por asignarme a esta Parroquia, llevarme de regreso a Downey donde viví y fui a la escuela secundaria y preparatoria y luego ir al Seminario de nuestra parroquia vecina, Nuestra Señora del Perpetuo Socorro.

Ahora que me quedo, debo hacer les una pregunta difícil. ¿Qué estamos haciendo para prepararnos para tener un pastor nuevo, el día en que me retire? ¿Estamos alentando a los jóvenes a pensar en una vocación al sacerdocio? ¿Lo mencionas en conversaciones en casa o con gente joven? Pensemos en formas que podamos alentar a las personas a responder al llamado de Dios a servir como sacerdotes y hermanas.
